
Key Contest Features

- ★ Ten image limit




Skill Levels

- ★ Mother Nature at her best and worst




Subject: Travel

Picture Perfect Rules

- ★ Image and editing must be yours alone
- ★ Images **can not** have been submitted in any previous photo contest(s)
- ★ **Any image** is a potential winner as long as ends up in digital image format

Picture Perfect Rules

- ★ Contest entry is de facto permission for the Pi to use any submitted image on its Web site, in the Pi Journal, the Pi News newsletter, and for printed display — all other rights reside with the contestant.

Submissions

- ★ TIFF or JPEG digital image files only
- ★ 10 image limit per entrant
- ★ 5 image limit per subject

Here Comes da Judge!

- ★ Two impartial judges recruited from North Bethesda Camera Club
- ★ Not the same judges as last contest
- ★ Each judge has vast experience in photography and judging

Enter via Email

- ★ One image attached per each email
- ★ Photographer identification, image info in email body along with certification
- ★ Send email NLT May 1st — 6:00 p.m. to pipphotocontest@wap.org
- ★ Use WAP email account, no restrictions

- ★ Make arrangements to hand deliver to the Clubhouse or to a contest representative (Mgmt Committee member)
- ★ Mail to Clubhouse on a CD or DVD
- ★ Entries due by 6:00 p.m. - May 1st
